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Employer Compliance with Phase I and II

Phase I and II:

- ✓ Continue to close common areas where personnel are likely to congregate and interact.
- ✓ Enforce strict social distancing protocols.
- ✓ Use of masks and footies.
- ✓ Temperature stations.
- ✓ Sanitizing stations.
- ✓ Minimize non-essential travel.
- ✓ If you have employees on the road, no more than one person in a vehicle at all times.
- ✓ Multiple daily disinfecting of vehicles, workstations, computers, keyboards, door handles, etc.
- ✓ Keep office closed to outside visitors.
- ✓ Have employees report to work in staggered schedules.
- ✓ Encourage tele-work whenever possible and feasible.

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Employer Compliance with Phase III

Phase III:

- ✓ Resume unrestricted staffing of work sites.
- ✓ Employee temperature checks
- ✓ Sanitizing stations
- ✓ Consider continuation of disinfection program and other protective covering.
