## **BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT**

- Welcomed over 110 government and business leaders from 23 countries, including five Ambassadors, and seven Consul Generals.
- Successfully executed a trade mission to Belgium focusing on hydrogen development and a trade mission to Rotterdam focusing on maritime and logistics
- Co-hosted the Louisiana International Wind Exchange, a networking event wherein Louisiana offshore wind companies were presented with networking opportunities with foreign delegations
- Attended SelectUSA, meeting with over 20 foreign companies and government officials, generating three qualified leads
